Weekend away 18th – 20th May 2018

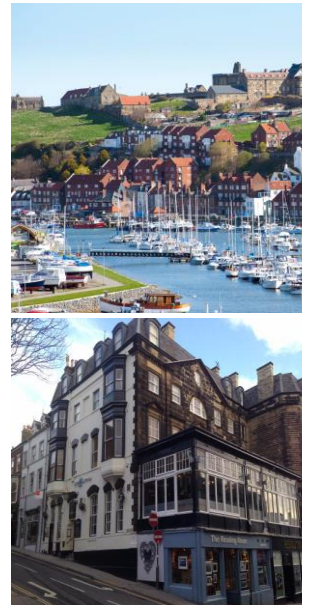
The Resolution Hotel sits proudly above Whitby's charming town centre with spectacular views of the world famous Abbey, the Harbour and Pannett Park. It's a perfect central location with comfortable accommodation, lounge bar and traditional restaurant. Standard twin/doubles are available at £99.95 per room per night room with breakfast included. Better rooms are available at a premium. There are no singles.

If members want to attend, its full payment up front, monies can be paid directly into the LCRA account (Mail Will Harris for bank details). There is a mini-bus priced at £30 per head providing we can get 16 on it. As well as the hotel being paid £10 per head deposits are requested for the mini-bus, this is a first come first served offer. We also have a cut-off of the Sunday 25th March, so you have to decide quickly.

An open letter to the members of the club from Chris Dobbin Re. Membership Referendum

I am pleased to confirm that the recent referendum on changing the Constitution to give Non-Catholic unrestricted rights of Membership save in the matter of spiritual matters, was approved with a majority of 90% of those voting.

Whilst in the process of arranging the referendum, I was disturbed to learn that some members were putting a different interpretation on the terms under which the Club has operated since the Constitution was amended in 1991, when Non Catholics were admitted to Membership on certain terms. We are and always have been Liverpool Catholic Ramblers Association, open to Non-Catholics, and no change in the rules and Constitution has taken place since 1991, until the recent Referendum altered the position on the 16th October 2017. The comments made were in great danger of sabotaging my efforts to do what I considered was the best for the Club. I have served the club on the Committee for almost 60 years and worked alongside Non Catholic Members for many of those years. I can honestly say that they are among the most enthusiastic Members in the Club and have always respected the fact that we are the Catholic Rambler's.

I have considered that the changes in the Constitution recently approved were in the best interests of the Club and its future, I have appreciated the pleasure which the Club has given me over the years, and I would only want to do the best for the Club and not for my benefit but for the benefit of those who are to come after me.

The LCRA is open to Non-Catholic Members and conducts walks on numerous Sundays throughout the year. They vary in length and physical demands and are in 3 grades: - A, B and C.

All walks are led by experienced ramblers.

A walks can be 10 to 15 miles and are for the more experienced ramblers.

B are shorter.

C are shorter still and can be 7 to 8 miles.

Consideration is given in advance to the difficulty of the course, the terrain, whether stiles, steep hills, or busy roads are to be crossed, and the numbers who may be expected to take part.

Cancellations must be made prior to the ramble otherwise members will be liable to pay the full charge for an empty coach seat
Coach departs at 9.00am prompt unless otherwise stated

The subscription are £6 per year (single) and £8 per year (couples).

Subscription is renewed each September. The first 2 walks are complimentary but prospective members must submit completed membership forms on the 3rd booking
